Highway 47 detour for culvert replacement

Motorists will be detoured for roadwork on Mist-Clatskanie Highway from Oct. 11-19

A contractor for the Oregon Department of Transportation will temporarily close Highway 47 (Mist-Clatskanie Highway) to replace a culvert pipe 7.6 miles south of the U.S. 30 (Lower Columbia River Highway) junction. The culvert is just north of Conyers Creek Road.

Highway 47 will be closed approximately one mile north and south of the culvert site from **7 a.m. on Thursday, Oct. 11, through 7 a.m. on Friday, Oct. 19**. Motorists will be detoured for two miles on a logging road that runs parallel to Highway 47. Flaggers and pilot cars will be on site at both ends of the detour to direct motorists during the repair work.

The detour will allow crews to dig up the roadway, remove soil and the old pipes, install a new culvert pipe, place fill around the pipe and repave Highway 47. The failed culvert was temporarily repaired by ODOT earlier this year.
