### **Paving to close I-5 ramps this weekend**

#### ***I-5 north ramp to Highway 217, Carman Drive ramps closing Friday, Saturday nights***

A contractor for the Oregon Department of Transportation will close ramps this weekend as part of the Interstate 5 paving project between Capitol Highway and the Tualatin River (just south of the Lower Boones Ferry Road interchange). Ramp closures will take place at intermittent times on **Friday night, Sept. 7, and Saturday night, Sept. 8, 11 p.m. to 8 a.m.**, as follows:

- ◆ The northbound I-5 flyover ramp (exit 292A) to Highway 217 will be closed during work hours from Friday night, Sept. 7, to Saturday morning, Sept. 8; and Saturday night, Sept. 8 to Sunday morning, Sept. 9. Motorists bound for Highway 217 will be directed via a signed detour route to I-5 exit 292B (Kruse Way/72<sup>nd</sup> Avenue) during this ramp closure
- ◆ The Carman Drive on-ramp to northbound I-5 will be closed intermittently Friday and Saturday nights during work hours. The closure will allow the contractor to pave the right side auxiliary lane from Carman Drive to Kruse Way
- ◆ The Carman Drive/King City off-ramp, exit 291, from northbound I-5 also will be closed intermittently during paving work hours on Friday and Saturday night

All other ramps in the project area will be open this weekend.

#### **I-5 paving project**

A project to pave both directions of I-5 between Capitol Highway and the Tualatin River is under way. The 4.5-mile preservation project also includes shoulder widening, bridge deck overlays, median barrier replacement, improved drainage and a new permanent variable message sign on Barbur Boulevard. The paving project is scheduled for completion by Oct. 31, 2007.
