### **Weekend ramp closures on I-5, Fremont Bridge**

***Electrical, expansion joint and barrier repairs require closures on Friday and Saturday***

Oregon Department of Transportation maintenance crews will be working at several locations this weekend. There will be ramp closures associated with this work, with locations and times as follows:

- ◆ **Friday night, Nov. 16, 11:45 p.m. to Saturday morning, Nov. 17, 6 a.m.** Crews will make expansion joint repairs on the Fremont Bridge. The repairs will require the full closure of the ramp connecting eastbound U.S. 30 (Lower Columbia River Highway) to southbound Interstate 405. During the closure, motorists can take the ramp connecting eastbound U.S. 30 to northbound Fremont Bridge/I-405, then travel across the Willamette River to southbound Interstate 5 to their destination
- ◆ **Sunday morning, Nov. 18, 6 a.m. to 10 a.m.** Crews will close the Terwilliger Boulevard off-ramp (Exit 297) from northbound Interstate 5 to make electrical repairs to ramp lighting. Motorists will be detoured to the Barbur Boulevard/Highway 99W (Exit 294) off-ramp from northbound I-5, then travel north on Barbur Boulevard/Highway 99W to Terwilliger Boulevard
- ◆ **Sunday morning, Nov. 18, 6 a.m. to 10 a.m.** Crews will close the Multnomah Boulevard on-ramp to northbound I-5 for barrier repairs. During the closure, motorists will be directed north on Barbur Boulevard/Highway 99W to the Terwilliger Boulevard on-ramp to northbound I-5
