Lane, ramp closures for Portland Marathon

Race on Sunday, Oct. 7, will close lanes and ramps on some regional roadways

To help facilitate the safe running of the Portland Marathon on Sunday, Oct. 7, the Oregon Department of Transportation will close lanes and ramps on area roadways as follows:

- ◆ The exit from northbound Interstate 405 to 4th Avenue will be closed between 6 a.m. and 8:30 a.m.
- ◆ Both eastbound lanes of the St. Johns Bridge will be closed from 7 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. The westbound lanes will be split during the eastbound closure, with one lane open to motorists traveling in each direction.
- ◆ The right lane of eastbound U.S. 30 will be closed from the St. Johns Bridge to Kittridge Avenue from 6:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.
- ◆ The ramp from southbound Interstate 5 to the Morrison Bridge will be closed from 6 a.m. to 9 a.m. The Belmont Street/Highway 99E connection will remain open
