Update: Expect delays for repair work on U.S. 30 near Clatskanie

Cleanup, culvert repair work continues following damage from December storms

Contractors for the Oregon Department of Transportation continue to work on cleaning up and repairing culverts along U.S. 30 between Clatskanie (mile post 63) and the Columbia/Clatsop county line (mile post 70). Work to repair significant damage on U.S. 30 from December storms began about a month ago.

Motorists driving east or west along this stretch of highway should expect delays of up to 20 minutes during the next several weeks. Flaggers and pilot cars are intermittently being used to control both directions of traffic at various locations in this 7-mile stretch of U.S. 30 when work crews are in the travel lanes.

Work hours are generally weekdays from 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Delays are not expected when work crews are not present in the area.
