TRAFFIC ADVISORY

I-5 Victory Blvd. off-ramp closed Saturday night

I-5 northbound off-ramp to Victory Blvd. and the Expo Center (exit 306B) closes at 8 p.m.

The Oregon Department of Transportation contractor working on the Interstate 5 Delta Park widening project plans to realign the I-5 northbound Victory Boulevard off-ramp Saturday night.

This work will require **closing the I-5 northbound Victory Blvd/Expo Center off-ramp (exit 306B) starting at 8 p.m. Saturday night, Sept. 26, to 9 a.m. Sunday morning, Sept. 27.**

During the off-ramp closure, flaggers will intermittently control traffic on Victory Blvd.

In preparation for the off-ramp closure, crews will work on the shoulders of the Victory Blvd/Expo Center off-ramp (exit 306B) Saturday afternoon. Motorists should be alert to crews and equipment on the roadway.

Detour:

Motorists traveling to Victory Blvd. from I-5 northbound will be directed north on I-5 to the Oregon 99E- Marine Drive/Delta Park off-ramp (exit 307). Detour signs will be in place to direct motorists to Victory Blvd.
