### **U.S. 26 overnight tunnel closure postponed tonight**

The planned overnight closure tonight of the U.S. 26 (Sunset Highway) Dennis Edwards Tunnel is postponed as crews work to clear a landslide on neighboring Oregon Highway 6 (Wilson River Highway).

The landslide dumped more than 1,000 cubic yards on Oregon Highway 6 near Tillamook Sunday closing the highway between Tillamook and Oregon Highway 8. U.S. 26 is serving as the detour route to and from the coast as crews work to remove debris and stabilize the hillside along Highway 6.
