## TRAFFIC ADVISORY

### **Early morning traffic stops on I-5 Friday**

***Workers installing a sign bridge means delays up to 30 minutes Friday morning***

A contractor for the Oregon Department of Transportation will install a sign bridge on Interstate 5 southbound just south of Southwest Carmen Drive Thursday night, requiring left lane closures in both directions and slowing of all southbound lanes.

To prepare for the sign bridge installation, the contractor will close the left lanes of I-5 in both directions between Carmen Drive and Tualatin Thursday, Dec. 29 from 10 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. Friday, Dec. 30.

Installation of the sign bridge will occur just south of Carmen Drive. Starting Friday at 1 a.m. crews will slow down all lanes of traffic on I-5 southbound beginning at Haines Street and ending at Lower Boones Ferry Road. The rolling slowdown will last 30 minutes and drivers should expect intermittent traffic stops during this period.
