## TRAFFIC ADVISORY

### **Tonight: emergency repair closes lanes on I-5**

*Guardrail repair closes connecting lanes on the upper deck of the Marquam Bridge*

Oregon Department of Transportation crews will perform emergency repairs to a guardrail damaged in a crash earlier today on Interstate 5 northbound at the I-5 and Interstate 405 split, at the south end of the Marquam Bridge. **This work will require closing the upper deck of the Marquam Bridge to motorists heading onto I-5 northbound from I-405 southbound. Motorists already on I-5 north will be able to continue onto the Marquam Bridge.**

**To prevent motorists from entering the work zone, crews will close the right lane of I-405 southbound beginning at S.W. 6<sup>th</sup> Ave. and close the S.W. 5<sup>th</sup> Ave. and S.W. Broadway on-ramps to I-405 southbound.**

**The closure will begin at 9:30 p.m. tonight (Monday) through midnight.** During the work, the left and center lanes of I-405 southbound will remain open. Motorists will be able to access I-5 southbound from I-405 southbound.

**Detour:**

Motorists traveling from I-405 southbound to I-5 northbound can take I-5 southbound to S.W. Terwilliger Blvd. (exit 297) and then loop back to I-5 northbound.

Motorists should expect delays during this closure and watch for crews and equipment on the roadway.
