Upcoming lane and ramp closures on I-5

Emergency paving project Saturday and Monday will impact motorists on I-5 north

A contractor for the Oregon Department of Transportation will close ramps and lanes on sections of Interstate 5 in the Portland Metro area to perform emergency paving operations on **Saturday, Jan. 10, and Monday, Jan. 12**. Motorists should expect delays during the work, which is scheduled to take place as follows:

- **On Saturday, Jan 10, crews will close the right lane of I-5 north from Burnside to Broadway from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.** The left lane will remain open at all times. The right lane closure also will require the closure of the ramp from Interstate 84 west to I-5 north and the ramp from I-5 north to Weilder Street (exit 302A). Motorists traveling west on I-84 who wish to travel to I-5 north can instead take I-5 south to Interstate 405 north to I-5 north. Motorists on I-84 west headed for the Rose Quarter can instead travel on I-5 south to I-405 north to I-5 south to the Rose Quarter.
- **On Monday night, Jan. 12, crews will close the right two lanes of I-5 north from Rosa Parks to Columbia Boulevard.** The left lane will remain open at all times. The closure of the right two lanes will require the closure of the Rosa Parks Way on-ramp to I-5 north. The ramp and lane closures will take place from 8 p.m. Monday night to 5 a.m. Tuesday morning.
