Interstate 5 paving project open houses this week

The 18-month project will extend from the Tualatin River to the Willamette River in Wilsonville

Work is underway on a \$23 million project to pave Interstate 5 from the Tualatin River to the Willamette River in Wilsonville. A local company Kodiak Pacific Construction of Sherwood, OR was awarded the project and completion is slated for November 2010.

Two project open houses are scheduled this week for the public to learn more about the project, including construction schedule and impacts. Details are as follows:

- **July 8, 2009, 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m., Tualatin Police Department, 8650 SW Tualatin Rd.**
- **July 9, 2009, 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m., Wilsonville City Hall, 29799 SW Town Center Loop East**

The project encompasses a 7-mile stretch of Interstate 5 spanning Tualatin and Wilsonville and includes the following elements:

- Grind, inlay, and restripe both directions of I-5 within the project limits
- Repave select freeway on- and off-ramps
- Widen left shoulders and select right shoulders of the freeway
- Add an auxiliary lane on I-5 northbound from the Boone Bridge over the Willamette River to the Wilsonville Rd. off-ramp
- Add an auxiliary lane on I-5 southbound from Interstate 205 southbound to the Elligsen Rd./N. Wilsonville off-ramp
- Build a new sound wall along I-5 southbound from I-205 to just north of Norwood Rd. in Tualatin

- Improve guardrail, barrier, and highway signage
- Overlay bridge decks on the I-5/I-205 ramps
- Repair bridge guardrails on the Wilsonville Rd. overpasses
- Widen the Nyberg St. off-ramp from I-5 southbound

Traffic Impacts

Motorists on I-5 and I-205 in the project area will experience **nighttime lane closures throughout the duration of the project**. Motorists should expect delays while traveling on the freeway.

Federal Stimulus Funds

The American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 contributed \$5 million in federal stimulus funds to this project.
