## TRAFFIC ADVISORY

### Paving closes I-84 exit in Troutdale this week

***Exit 17 ramps will close overnight from 10 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. starting Wednesday, Sept. 21***

The contractor working on the Interstate 84 Troutdale Interchange Project will close the Exit 17 off-ramps to Frontage Road overnight Wednesday, Sept. 21 to Wednesday, Sept. 28. During the closures, motorists will follow a detour using the Northeast 238<sup>th</sup> Avenue off-ramp (exit 16).

The ramp closures will take place as listed below:

- The I-84 westbound off-ramp to Northwest Frontage Road will close overnight for three nights from 10 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. Wednesday, Sept. 21 through Friday, Sept. 23.
- The I-84 eastbound off-ramp to Frontage Road will close overnight for three nights from 10 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. Monday, Sept. 26 through Wednesday, Sept. 28.

#### **Detour:**

During the ramp closures, motorists will be detoured to Exit 16 (238th Avenue). The detour takes motorists south on 238th Avenue to Halsey, then east to 257th, then north to Exit 17. All other ramps at the Troutdale interchange (Exit 17) will be open during the nighttime work.

**\*\*Please note that trucks can't use Exit 18 because of height restrictions. Message signs on I-84 will warn truck drivers not to use Exit 18.**

Closing the off-ramps will allow the contractor to pave the ramp and place temporary barriers and striping in preparation of widening work. This work is weather dependent and the schedule can change if wet weather occurs.
