Flaggers direct traffic on Lombard next week

Paving work will take place between N Gilbert and N Macrum from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

A contractor for the Oregon Department of Transportation will pave a section of North Lombard Street (U.S. 30 Bypass) between North Gilbert Avenue and North Macrum Avenue next week. Paving work requires flagging traffic on Lombard Street and closing the Peninsula Trail crosswalk at Lombard Street.

Paving work will take approximately two days the week of Oct. 17 from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. each day. This work is weather dependent and the contractor will only pave on dry days. If the weather is dry, ODOT hopes to complete the paving by Tuesday evening.

Peninsula Trail Crosswalk Detour

Peninsula Trail users crossing at Lombard Street will cross at Macrum Avenue just a half a block to the east of the trail and then head west to reconnect with the trail.

The Peninsula Trail crosswalk closure will occur only during the paving work.

People using Lombard Street should expect delays and plan ahead for extra time when traveling in this area.
