## TRAFFIC ADVISORY

### **OR 281 closed next week for culvert replacement**

**Daytime closures from 6 a.m. to 5 p.m. at Summit Drive will take place May 24-27**

The Oregon Department of Transportation today announced it will replace three failing culverts on OR 281 (Tucker Road) between OR 282 (Odell Highway) and the intersection of Summit Drive/Dee Highway, approximately 5 miles south of Hood River.

This work requires closing Tucker Road to all vehicles for four days between Odell Highway and Summit Drive. The road daily closures begin **Monday, May 24, and continues through Thursday, May 27**, between 6 a.m. and 5 p.m. Tucker Road will open each evening from 5 p.m. to 6 a.m. the next morning.

**Detour:**

During the closure, detour signs will direct motorists from OR 281 (Tucker Road) to Odell Highway (OR 282) and Summit Road to get back to OR 281.

Residents who live on this section of Tucker Road will be allowed access to their driveways. Between the closure hours of 6 a.m. to 5 p.m., local traffic will need to approach/depart their destination using Summit Drive.
