WEEKEND LANE AND RAMP WORK

Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) maintenance crews will temporarily close lanes and ramps on several ODOT owned roads this weekend. Closure dates, locations and hours are listed below.

Interstate 205

Saturday, June 3, crews will close the ramp from southbound Interstate 205 to eastbound Interstate 84. The ramp closure will be in place from 10 p.m. Saturday until 5 a.m. Sunday, June 4 to allow workers to complete electrical and concrete work. During the overnight ramp closure, motorists headed for eastbound I-84 will take the Glisan Street off-ramp from southbound I-205, turn left onto Glisan Street and then follow the signs to eastbound I-84. Detour signs will be in place to assist motorists.

Highway 99E (McLoughlin Boulevard)

Saturday, June 3, a utility contractor will close one lane in each direction of Highway 99E at Woodward Street. The lane closures will be in place from 11:30 p.m. Saturday until 6 a.m. Sunday, June 4. One lane will remain open in each direction at all times.

Interstate 5

Sunday, June 4, crews will close one lane on the I-5 overpass from Highway 99E (Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard) to Marine Drive for sign replacement work. The on-ramp to southbound I-5 will also be closed. Motorists headed for southbound I-5 will take the I-5 northbound on-ramp to Jantzen Beach and will follow the signs to southbound I-5. The lane and ramp closures will be in place from 4:30 a.m. to 9:00 a.m.
