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## **Operations Program**

The Operations Program makes system management improvements that lead to more efficient and safe travel and greater system reliability. ODOT operates and maintains 7,500 centerline miles of highway.

Region 1 Funding: \$26.121 million over four years

### **Considerations for Selecting Operations Projects:**

- Slides and Rockfalls
- Hazards, average daily traffic, highway classification, local knowledge, ODOT Rockfall Hazard Rating System
- Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS)
  - o Urban Traffic Management – relief of traffic congestion
    - Reduction in travel times and increase in safety
  - o Rural ITS – increase safety
  - o Travel Information Services
    - Information delivery
  - o ITS for Public Transportation
    - Increase mobility of Oregonians
    - Increase accessibility of public transportation
- Signs, Signals, and Illumination (Upgrade/Replacement)
  - o Age of equipment
  - o Problem areas
- Transportation Demand Management – use of alternative modes of transportation
  - o Reduction in vehicle miles traveled
  - o Reduction in traffic congestion
  - o Improve air quality
  - o Enhance mobility
  - o Improve efficiency
