Safety Program

The Safety Program makes improvements which address highway locations and corridors, including the interstate, in order to reduce the number of fatal and severe injury crashes.

Region 1 Funding:

2008 = \$15.160M (based on actual)

2009 = \$12.610M (based on actual)

2010 = \$13.832M (new allocation)

2011 = \$14.456M (new allocation)

Total = \$56.058M over four years

Considerations for Selecting Safety Projects:

- Safety Improvement Program (database over 3 year period)
- Safety Priority Index System – specific hazardous locations
- Integration with Preservation and Modernization Projects
- Benefit/Cost
- Public Input
- Cost effectiveness
