



A new highway and shared-use path are opening soon in Clackamas, one of the state's busiest areas.

The **Sunrise Expressway** (OR 224) extends the Milwaukie Expressway to the intersection of SE 122nd Avenue and Clackamas Highway (OR 212/224). Once open on July 1, the new highway will take pressure off surrounding roads, reducing congestion and improving travel times for everyone in the area. In addition, those using the shared-use path will enjoy easy, car-free travel and recreation.

Complete after three years of construction, the **Sunrise Expressway** is the first new highway in the Portland metro area in over 30 years.

Benefits for cars and trucks using the Sunrise Expressway:

- Reduced congestion on area roads including OR 212/224 and I-205.
- Less backed-up traffic at I-205 exits 12 and 13.
- Faster connections to I-205 north and southbound from the east.
- Faster travel east toward Mt. Hood.

Group Bike Ride on the Shared-Use Path 5:30 to 7:00 pm on June 30th.

Cyclists will gather at Clackamas Town Center at the Shared-Use Path near the TriMet Max Stop at 5:30 p.m. Ride begins promptly at 6 p.m.



How to drive to the new Sunrise Expressway

To and from:

I-205 northbound and southbound at exit 13

Access at east end:

OR 212/224 at SE 122nd Avenue

Access at west end:

Milwaukie Expressway (OR 224)

SE 82nd Avenue

Ambler Drive

SE 82nd Drive (enter only)
