


New six-lane highway being considered in Clackamas.

Clackamas County and the Oregon Department of Transportation have refined design alternatives for the proposed Sunrise Project, a new limited access highway from I-205 to the Rock Creek Junction.

In the 1990s, the project was proposed as a four-lane facility, but growth in the area warrants consideration of a larger facility. There is one general alignment with several design options related to connections at I-205, the middle of the project (between 122nd and 135th) and a transition at the east (between the Hwy 212 /224 junction and 172nd).

In November, Advisory Committee and partner agencies will recommend which design options move forward in the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) phase. The EIS will evaluate the impacts of building the project. By late 2006, a preferred alternative should be selected. Construction could begin as early as 2009.


