

National Average Source: The National Average of DVMT/ Person is calculated from 'Total DVMT,' for all Federal-Aid Urban Areas, divided by total 'Estimated Population,' as it appears on Sheet 9, of Table HM-72; which lists all the Federal-Aid Urbanized Areas in the U.S. The 1990-2006 data is located in the above cited booklet and website.

Federal-Aid Urbanized Area is an area with 50,000 or more persons that, at a minimum, encompasses the land area delineated as the urbanized area by the Bureau of the Census" (from Roadway Footnotes for HM-72, page V-84 of 'Highway Statistics 2006' - listed above). Portland-Vancouver, OR-WA is a Federal-Aid Urbanized Area.
