Brookwood Parkway Interchange Projects Moving Forward

The U.S. 26 Brookwood Parkway/Helvetia Interchange project, a JTA project (see reverse for details), will reduce congestion, improve safety and freight mobility, and increase economic development opportunities in the interchange area. Elements include:

- ◆ Constructing a new westbound U.S. 26 to southbound Brookwood Parkway exit loop ramp
- ◆ Reconstructing the westbound U.S. 26 entrance ramp
- ◆ Installing an additional northbound travel lane on the Brookwood Parkway overcrossing and widening the structure to accommodate an additional future southbound lane
- ◆ Extending the northbound right-turn lane from Brookwood Parkway to eastbound U.S. 26
- ◆ Enhancing bicycle and pedestrian accommodations on the Brookwood Parkway overcrossing

The project is currently being designed. Construction is estimated to begin in 2013 and to be complete in 2015.

In conjunction with the U.S. 26: Brookwood Parkway/Helvetia Interchange project, ODOT, the City of Hillsboro and Washington County are working on an **Interchange Area Management Plan (IAMP)**.

The purpose of the IAMP is to:

- ◆ Support the JTA Brookwood Parkway/Helvetia Interchange project;
- ◆ Support ongoing and future City of Hillsboro and Washington County transportation, land use, and economic development planning efforts in and around the study area; and
- ◆ Protect the future function of the Brookwood Parkway/Helvetia interchange.

The IAMP is scheduled to be complete summer 2012 and adopted fall 2012.



Jobs and Transportation Act



The Oregon Jobs and Transportation Act (House Bill 2001) is the transportation funding plan approved by the 2009 Oregon Legislature. Three core themes emerged from the legislation:

- ◆ accountability, innovation and environmental stewardship;
- ◆ highway, road and street funding; and
- ◆ multimodal funding.

Additional provisions address important elements of Oregon's transportation system and our statewide economy.

The JTA identified 37 specific highway projects (plus transportation funding for 12 local governments in eastern Oregon). These projects and allocations total \$960.3 million. In ODOT Region 1, there are eight JTA projects, including the U.S. 26: Brookwood Parkway/Helvetia Interchange project.
