

Car Seat Assistance Program

If you need help to purchase a car seat, we may be able to help thanks to a community partnership with several agencies.

- To be eligible the parent/guardian must provide income eligibility, such as a WIC, OHP or Oregon Trail card, and currently need a new car seat—as determined at a car seat safety check.
- **Important! Call 503-561-5138 to make an appointment to purchase a low cost seat.**
- The **\$30 co-pay per seat** must be paid at the time the seat is received. There is a \$10 co-pay for a “no back” booster seat. You will need to show your (or your child’s) WIC, OHP or Oregon Trail card.
- Seats are available once a month, by appointment, during the Car Seat Safety Clinic. This event is held the third Saturday of each month from 11–3 p.m. in various locations in Salem, Keizer and Dallas.
- Seats are only provided to parents or legal guardians, who must be present to obtain the seat. Only one seat per child.
- The child receiving the seat must be present unless the baby is not yet born.
- The vehicle in which the child travels must be brought to the car seat check.
- Parents or guardians will be taught to correctly install and use the car seat.
