PROJECT PURPOSE AND NEED

Aging signals throughout downtown Astoria need to be replaced. Standard signal foundations to support the new poles, mast arms, and signal heads may be in conflict with the existing chair walls that supports the city's sidewalks and historic buildings. The chair wall system also supports the highway within state ROW. This section of Astoria is federally designated as an historic district.

ODOT will perform an engineering study of the existing chair walls and design options for signal foundations. Context sensitive and sustainable solutions (CSSS) will be incorporated to include local stakeholders and ODOT technical staff.
