OR 99W: OR 240 (Newberg) – OR 18 (McDougal Jct)

Project location

This project is on OR 99W (Pacific Highway West) and begin at the OR 240 Junction, (Main Street, Newberg). It goes south through Dundee to the Intersection with OR 18 at McDougal Junction

Project purpose and need

This is a Pavement Preservation project. The Road surface pavements have reached the end of their design life.

Construction overview

- Repave the surface of the roadway
- Upgrade ADA ramps to meet current standards
- Replace non serviceable signs to meet current standards
- Replace roadside markers
- Upgrade Guardrail to meet current standards
- Due to the high volume of traffic, work that will require closure of a travel lane will be performed at night

Cost estimate

- Estimated construction cost—\$7,000,000
- Federal and State Funding through the Pavement Preservation Program and Sidewalk Improvement Program.

Key project milestones

- Project Design — June 2010 – March 2013
- Right of Way — ROW phase to begin December 2011
- Bid Let Date — Estimated for May 11, 2013
- Construction — Work will commence Summer 2011 and run through the Summer of 2012
