Interstate 5 Sign Replacement

Project location

This project is located between the south end of the Woodburn interchange and the Boone Bridge at Wilsonville (M.P. 270 – M.P. 283)

Project purpose and need

This project will replace signs and supports that are no longer serviceable or do not meet current design standards.

Construction overview

- Replace Signs and supports
- Work will be primarily contained to the shoulder area
- There may be some delays when installing overhead signs, (night work)
- Due to the high volume of traffic any work that will require closure of a travel lane will be performed at night

Cost estimate

- Estimated construction cost—\$2,000,000
- Federal and State Funding through the Interstate Maintenance Program.

Key project milestones

- Project Design — The design phase is scheduled from September 2009 – October 2010.
- Right of Way — This project will be completed within the existing highway right of way.
- Bid Let Date — Estimated for December 2010.
- Construction — Planned to begin Spring 2011.
