Project location

- OR 22(Willamina Salem Hwy) on the Marion Street Bridge and connection ramps

Project purpose and need

- Purpose of this project is to repair structural deficiencies and repave the travel surface of the bridge and ramps connecting to adjacent streets.



Construction overview

- Repair cracks in the bridge cross beams
- Remove existing asphalt, seal the bridge deck and repave
- Clean, inspect and repair expansion joints
- Remove existing asphalt and repave the Front St. on-ramp and the Wallace Road off-ramp
- Project will require lane closures for deck work, primarily at night/early morning
- Ramp work will require short term detours lasting the length of the shift, night work.
- No height, weight or length restrictions anticipated.

Cost estimate

- Estimated construction cost—\$3,206,000
