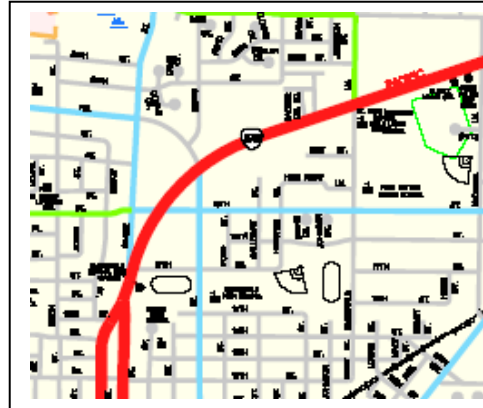

Project location

- Pacific Hwy West, OR 99W, At 3 Intersections, 27th St, McDaniel Lane & McDonald Lane (MP 35.65 – 36.85) In McMinnville.



Project purpose and need

- The signal @ McDonald Lane is due for replacement. McDonald Lane and McDaniel Lane both have a high number of rear end and left turn crashes. Signals are individually metered instead of interconnected with adjacent signalized intersections.

Construction overview

- This project will replace the signal @ McDonald Lane
- Improve the turning radii At McDonald Ln
- Address crashes at McDonald Ln and McDaniel Ln.
- Apply an access management strategy within the project limits.
- Interconnect the signal timing between 27th St (Wal-Mart), McDaniel Ln and McDonald Ln.
- Additional signals may be interconnected as budget allows.
- No height, weight or length restrictions anticipated.

Cost estimate

- Estimated construction cost—\$1,500,000
- Federal Funding through the Operation program and the Safety program
