State Highway Development and Construction in Marion, Polk and Yamhill Counties

OR99W: Sunset (Sherwood) – Brutscher (Newberg)

Project location

This pavement preservation project is located in Yamhill County from Sunset Blvd in Sherwood (MP 16.67) to Brutscher Street in Newberg (MP 21.78) on OR99W.

Project purpose and need

The purpose of this project is pavement preservation and minor safety enhancement which may include rumble strips, durable striping, delineators and pavement markers. This project is needed because the pavement is at the end of its service life and the safety enhancements should reduce the number of fixed object crashes.

Construction overview

- Rehabilitate the pavement
- Install shoulder rumble strips for safety
- Temporary construction delays but detours are not anticipated
- The 2006 Average Daily Traffic for this section is 37,300
- Due to the high volume of traffic, night time work is anticipated

Cost estimate

- Estimated construction cost—\$11,704,000
- Federal and State Funding through the Pavement Preservation Funds.

Key project milestones

- Project Design — The design phase is scheduled from April 2008 to Nov 2009.
- Right of Way — This project will be completed within the existing highway right of way.
- Bid Let Date — Estimated for April 2010.
- Construction — Planned to begin Summer 2010.

- ODOT will work closely with the City of Newberg, Yamhill County and emergency services.
