Shelton Ditch Bridge (#08111) Scour Repair Urgent Bridge Maintenance

Project location

- On OR 22/99E Business At Shelton Ditch Bridge (Intersection of Bellevue & 12th Street, Salem)

Project purpose and need

- This structure has experienced significant scour that is encroaching under the bridge footings. Prior measures to stop the scour are failing. The need for repair is considered URGENT and will be performed this summer.

Construction overview

- Remove failed scour protection
- Use Grout to stabilize the bridge footings
- Restore Stream bed
- Alley way between Oak Street and Bellevue will be closed for duration of the project to provide access to the stream and staging for the contractor
- Will require intermittent lane closures
- Work will be scheduled for off peak hours
- Night work and weekends will be offered to the contractor
- Work will commence June 1, 2009 and be completed by October 15, 2009 (In Water Work Window)

Cost estimate

- Estimated construction cost—\$200,000
- State Funding through Major Bridge Maintenance Program

Key project milestones

- Bid Let Date— April 2009
- Construction— Summer 2009
