PROJECT UPDATE



- **Developing a Facility Plan**

Why?

ODOT does not have enough funding to build all of the improvements needed on U.S. 101. Federal Highway Administration has told ODOT a facility plan that assures all the improvements could be constructed in the future has to be adopted to allow permission for affordable phases to be built instead.

What is it?

A facility plan establishes a public need for highway modernization and will provide overall guidance on needed improvements for this section of U.S. 101, including access management actions. It would identify the future highway improvements needed between 12th Street and High School Drive within the next 20 years, including sidewalks, multi-use paths, shared should/bike lanes, travel lanes and turn lanes.

- **What is next?**

ODOT and Lincoln City will need to develop and adopt the facility plan. The plan would need to be adopted before any phased highway project can be constructed. Construction plans for any phase of the project could not be prepared until the plan is adopted.

UPCOMING
