I-5: Sodom Ditch Calapooia Bundle 216

Project location

- Two bridge repairs and two bridge replacements on Interstate 5 in Linn County, about four miles north of Brownsville/Halsey exit 216, and 25 miles north of Eugene.

Project purpose and need

- The aging bridges are on Oregon's primary north/south travel and commerce corridor and are in need of replacement or repair.
- The Sodom Ditch bridges require replacement and widening. The Calapooia Overflow bridges require strengthening.

Construction overview

- Replace and widen the I-5 bridges in both directions over Sodom Ditch at milepost 221.1.
- Repair the I-5 bridges in both directions over Calapooia Overflow at milepost 220.0, by strengthening the bridges.
- Replacing the Sodom Ditch bridges will require building a temporary bridge to carry I-5 traffic during construction.
- No truck height, weight, width and/or length restrictions are anticipated.
- There will be local construction traffic.
- Construction will require some occasional nighttime lane closures on I-5.

Cost estimate

- Construction cost: \$11,988,520
- Construction contractor: Concrete Enterprises, Inc.
- Funding provided by the Oregon Transportation Investment Act.
