I-5 Bridge Vertical Clearance Improvements

Project location

- I-5 over crossings at Talbot Road (MP 242.13)
- Dever-Conner Road (MP 239.67)
- Grand Prairie Road (MP 231.91),
- Seven Mile Lane (MP 230.12)

Project purpose and need

- Improve vertical clearance on I-5 to accommodate permitted over height loads, which currently are required to use alternate routes through numerous small towns with substantial out of direction travel.

Construction overview

- Provide a minimum clearance of 16'-8".
- Construction is not expected to impact I-5 traffic, however there could be detours and/or minor delays on the over crossing roads.

Cost estimate

- Estimated construction cost - \$5.3 million.
- Funding source – federal earmark.
