OR34 Lint Creek (Indian Slough) Bridge (Waldport)

Project location

- This project is located on Highway 34, MP 0.55 – 0.61. The structure spans Lint Slough as the highway leads out of Waldport to the east.



Project purpose and need

- The purpose of this project is to repair the existing structure and install cathodic protection. The structure has severe cracking caused by heavy truck traffic and a corrosive coastal environment. The repair will bring the bridge to nearly new strength.

Construction overview

- Repair the existing structure.
- Since the project will mainly involve repairs under the bridge, the work will happen during low tides. Expect one lane closure and flagger controlled traffic. The repairs may also involve some night work.

Cost estimate

- Estimated construction cost is \$500,000 (STIP)
- This is a federally funded project.
