
OR99E: Halsey - Harrisburg Bridge Replacements

Project location

- This project is located on OR99E Albany to Junction City Highway between Halsey and Harrisburg in Linn County. Project limits are mileposts 20.57 (South of Halsey) to 28.44 (North of Harrisburg).

Project purpose and need

- This project will replace four bridges. Those bridges are Little Muddy Creek Bridge (MP 23.38), Creek Bridge (MP 24.06), Big Muddy Creek Bridge (MP 25.04), and Creek Bridge (MP 26.80). The pavement is worn and is in need of preservation from MP 20.57 to MP 28.44 and will receive a two inch overlay.



Construction overview

- Bridge construction will be staged over two years. One half of each bridge will be constructed per construction season.
- Traffic will be reduced to one lane with temporary signals at each bridge. Temporary lane closures can also be expected for paving work.
- There will be up to eight (8) full closures at night for pile driving and beam placement. A detour will be signed.
- Pavement through the section will be preserved by an overlay procedure.
