US101 Big Creek Bridge Repair

Project location

- This project is located on US101, north of Yachats at mile post 160.15 in Lincoln County.

Project purpose and need

- The bridge is in need of repairs. There are cracks, de-lamination of the concrete and exposed rebar on the superstructure. This project will repair the cracked concrete and add passive cathodic protection to prevent deterioration of the rebar.



Construction overview

- The majority of work will be done underneath the bridge.
- There will be containment structures underneath the bridge for the removal and repair of the cracked concrete.
- The project will not have any width restrictions for trucks.
- If necessary, APHIS will provide bird exclusion and monitoring.

Cost estimate

- Estimated construction cost—\$785,000
- Funding source: State and Federal
