US20 at Airport Road (Lebanon)

Project location

- This project is located at the intersection of US20 (Hwy 16) and Airport Rd in Lebanon at MP 14.07 – MP 14.17.

Project purpose and need

- Airport Road and US20 meet at this intersection. Cars and trucks heading east on Airport share a lane for through traffic and right turns. This results in a back-up of vehicles waiting to turn right onto US20.
- There have been numerous car wrecks at this intersection, It is one of the top accident sites in the Region.
- This project will construct a new right turn lane to reduce the stacking length and allow additional traffic flow. It will include new signal poles and signals.



Construction overview

- Construct new right turn lane from Airport Rd onto US 20 (Eastbound)
- Expect, temporary lane / shoulder closures during construction. These will generally happen at night.
- No height, or weight restrictions should be needed.
- No detour is anticipated.

Cost estimate

- Estimated total cost— \$1.349 m
- Funding source - This is a federally funded Safety / Operations project.
