## US20: Newton Creek (Philomath) – 99W (Corvallis)

### Project location

- This project is located on US20 (Philomath Blvd.), between Philomath and Corvallis (MP 51.31-55.75).
- The project starts at the east end of Philomath, and extends to the Hwy 99 over crossing in Corvallis.
- There is a no-work zone between SW 53<sup>rd</sup> Street, and just east of SW Technology Loop. This is where newer paving already exists.



### Project purpose and need

- This project is a pavement preservation project. Work will consist of grinding out some of the existing roadway, and then an inlay of new asphalt.
- Some deep rehabilitation will be conducted in areas of deeper damage.
- Guardrail and ADA ramp improvements will also be made.

### Construction overview

- Construction will begin in early summer of 2009.
- Crews will work at night to reduce delays, and impacts to area traffic.
- Traffic will be reduced to one lane with flaggers during the paving operations.

### Cost estimate

- Construction cost - \$1,465,000
- Contract awarded to Knife River
