I-5 @ Beltline Interchange Unit 2 (Eugene/Springfield)

Project location

- The project is located on I-5 at its intersection with Beltline Hwy at milepost 195.

Project purpose and need

- The purpose of the project is to improve safety and operation of the interchange. Unit one is currently under construction. Unit two will add additional elements toward the eventual goal of completing the interchange.

Construction overview

- Complete the northbound legs of the intersection.
- Construct a noise wall in the southwest quadrant just north of Harlow Road, extending to the EWEB substation. Purchase right of way and /or easements. Widen Beltline Road from I-5 to Gateway.
- In cooperation with the City of Springfield; incorporate the City's plans for improvements along Gateway Blvd, Game Farm Road, and Beltline Rd East into ODOT's plans, for the purpose of advertising, awarding, and construction engineering work. These improvements are the first stage of the City's phased approach to complete Phase II of the work as specified in the environmental assessment.

Cost estimate

- The project is currently funded at \$25.5M. This amount does not include an estimate for the City's portion of the proposed work, to be funded by the City. Financial considerations for other projects could impact this funding.

Key project milestones

- Environmental Work —Elements of the interchange were included in the (revised) environmental assessment that was completed in 2003.
- Project Design — An open house may be scheduled for a later date if requested by interested parties.
- Bid Let Date — 3/25/2010
- Construction — 2010
