State Highway Development and Construction in Linn, Benton and Lincoln Counties

I-5: Lane County Line – McKenzie River Bridge

Project location

This project is located on Interstate 5 between the Lane county line and the bridge at McKenzie River.

Project purpose

This is a pavement preservation project.

Project Description

The project will upgrade the pavement on Interstate 5 by grinding out two inches of the old asphalt and then replacing it with new asphalt.

Why the project is needed

Tens of thousands of cars, trucks, and motor homes move through this corridor on a daily basis. The wear and tear on the roadway is beginning to show, and could unravel quickly if nothing is done.

Current Status

The project has been designed and the contract was let to Wildish Construction for \$2.012 million. Construction is expected to begin in summer of 2012 and be completed by September of 2012.
