Jerry:

In regards to the modifications and additions to the US 199 Expressway Upgrade project design alternatives, the Region 3 Hazardous Materials Unit found a few changes from what was presented in the US 199 Technical Report completed in February 2006.

The Region 3 Hazmat section concludes that 28 hazmat sites (12 Identified and 16 Potential) could have impacts on the modified Alternative A and newly added Alternative C. These include sites #1-12, 17, 18, 20-30, 38, 39 and 41 (as presented in the Level 1 Corridor Study and Technical Report). This is slightly different than the 30 sites that were identified in the Technical Report as having potential of impacting the proposed Alternatives A and B. Sites #6 and #19 were dropped due to the elimination of the proposed frontage road located east of the Fairgrounds property. Although the number of sites has changed, the direct and indirect effects and impacts that these sites could potentially have on the project and surrounding area will be the same as those presented in the US 199 Technical Report.
