

US 20: Powell Butte Hwy. to Horse Ridge Frontage Rd.

Project Overview

The US 20: Powell Butte Hwy. – Horse Ridge Frontage Rd. project is located on the McKenzie-Bend Highway in Deschutes County and extends from the US 20/Powell Butte junction for approximately 7.5 miles along US 20 east of Bend. US 20 is a critical part of the State’s transportation system and a major east-west freight corridor across Oregon.

This stretch of highway is showing wearing and rutting and the pavement is in poor condition. The purpose of this project is to improve roadway condition and safety through pavement preservation and other improvements along this section of highway.

What is planned

This project will add onto previous improvements on US 20, repaving an additional 7.5 miles of highway from Powell Butte Highway (MP 5.1) to Horse Ridge Frontage Road (MP 12.4). This project will also replace substandard bridge rails and stabilize slopes.

Timeline & Cost

Project development – 2016 – 2017

Bid opening – Winter 2017

Construction – Spring 2018

Estimated cost - \$3.6 million
