This project is a combination preservation and safety project. As part of this project, ODOT plans

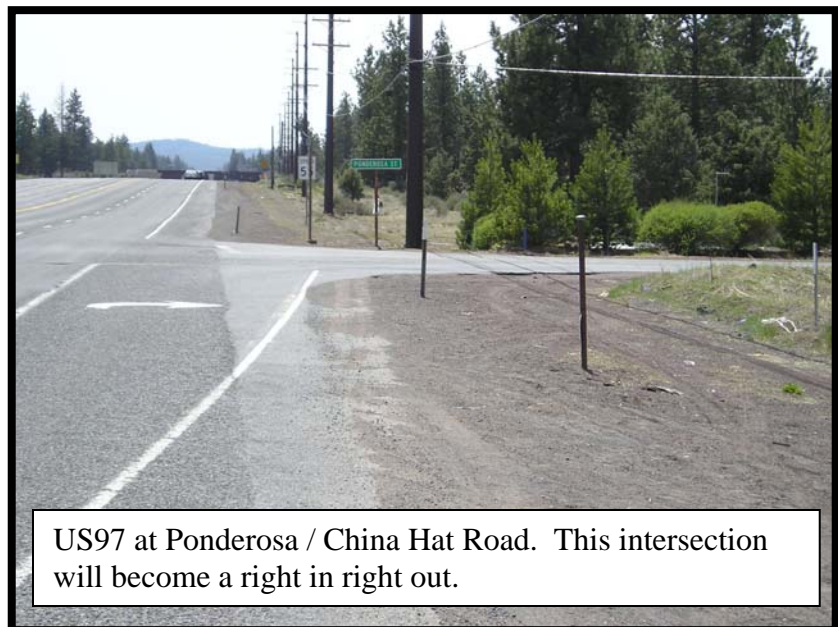
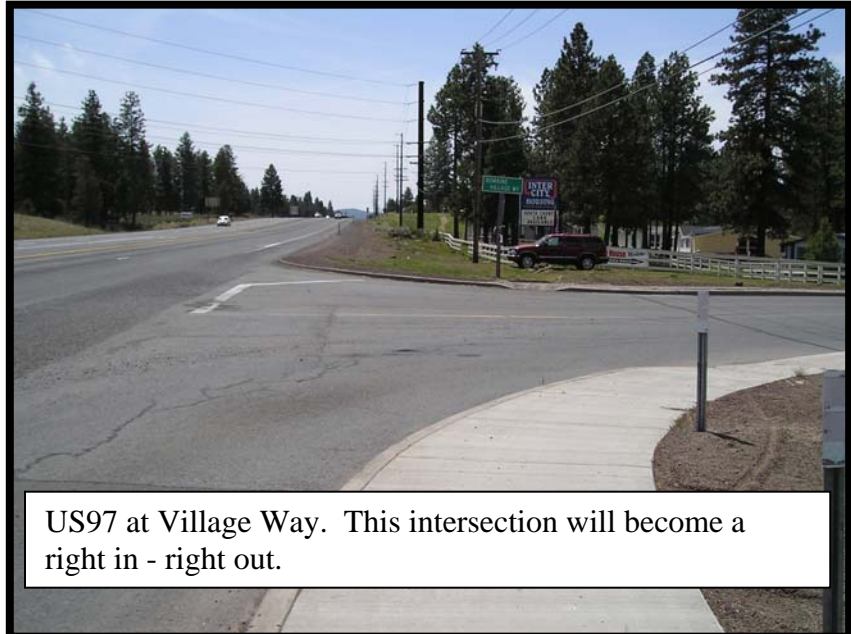
to repave US97 from Village Way to the weigh scales north of Lava Butte. The road through this section is rutting, cracking and raveling and is in desperate need of repair. Also as part of this project, a concrete median barrier will be constructed from the signal at the intersection of US97 (Parkway) and 3<sup>rd</sup> Street to the existing barrier on the North side of the railroad bridge. This section of highway is rated as one of the top crash sections in the state with numerous crashes occur throughout this five-lane section of highway. The barrier will restrict movements at intersections to right in – right out.
