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## Work on U.S. 395 (G Street) to begin May 18

***Between May 26 and July 2, parking along G Street will be restricted.***

Lakeview, OR – Construction along U.S. 395 in Lakeview will begin next week. The project was awarded to Hooker Creek of Bend, Oregon. The project will install sidewalks along U.S. 395 from North H Street to Highway 140 (North 4<sup>th</sup> Street), widen the turning radius in the northwest quadrant of the intersection of U.S. 395 and Highway 140 to better facilitate turning movements, and repave street approaches along U.S. 395 in the south part of town.

There will be parking restrictions along U.S. 395 between North H and 4<sup>th</sup> Streets during construction. Those restrictions are expected to be in place between May 26, and July 2.

The project will also correct a sharp curve in the Dick's Creek Road area 12 miles north of Lakeview. The unevenness and the steep "banking" of the curve will be corrected by repaving and smoothing out the roadway. And flashing lights will be installed on "Reduce Speed" signs. The flashers are activated when drivers enter the curve at unsafe speeds.

The project is scheduled to be completed by the end of September, 2009.
