OW15-10	Delete 4-74	WRECK AHEAD	Deleted. This sign is being given a new sign number (CW15-10) and color (fluorescent pink) designation consistent with incident management and has been moved to page 6-56.
OW15-14	4-78	PREPARE TO STOP WHEN LIGHTS FLASH	Added language re: need for an engineering study to justify use.
OD-411A	5-45	ENTERING CITY	Added another detail to differentiate spacing layout between 2 and 3-line legends. Added dimensioning and font information for freeway/expressway application. Added language to clarify number of accompanying signs allowed.
OD-412	5-46	ENTERING XX COUNTY	Added dimensioning and font information for freeway/expressway application. Added language to clarify number of accompanying signs allowed.

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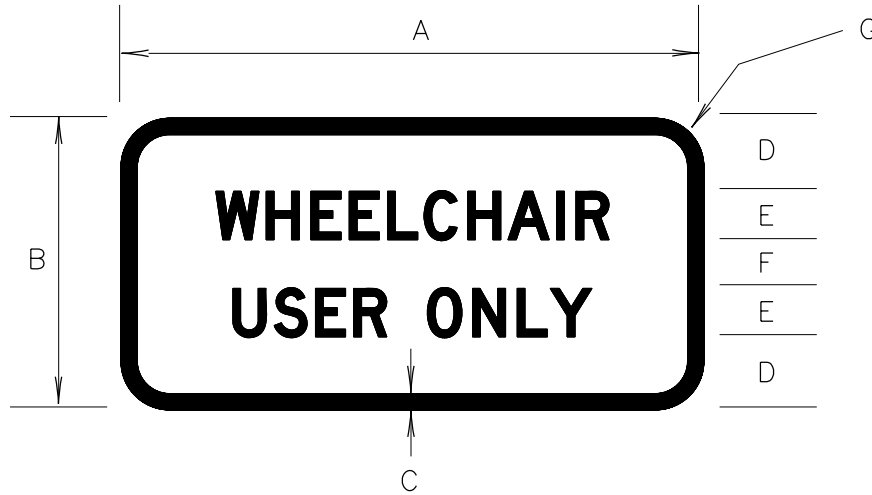

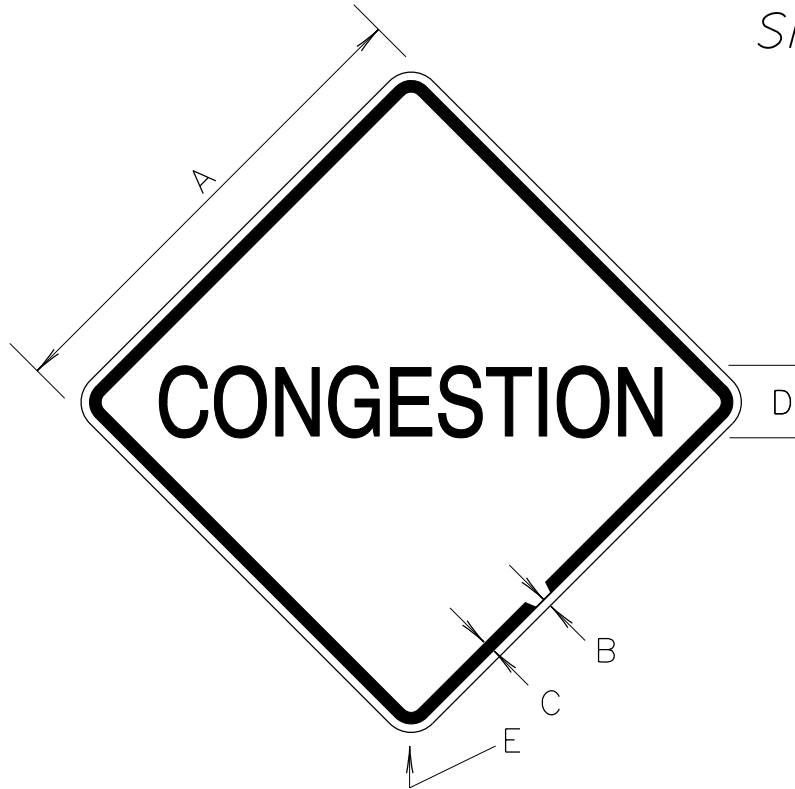

The CONGESTION sign may be used in advance of isolated sections of roadside development through which a reduction of speed is necessary, but which are too short to warrant the establishment of a speed zone. It may also be used within speed zones to call the motorist's attention to sections which are too short to justify a lower speed, but which experience congested conditions requiring a lower speed than that indicated.

The need for this sign should be determined upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation. This sign shall not be used on the interstate highway system. The message is not intended for interstate use.

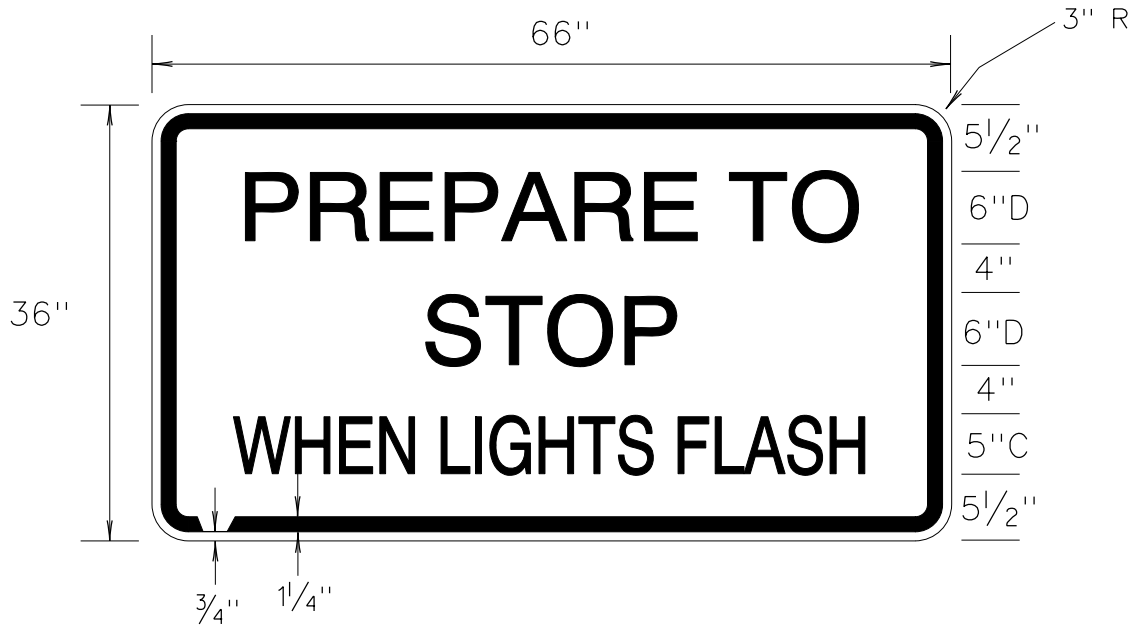

Sign Legend: Black, Non-reflective

The PREPARE TO STOP WHEN LIGHTS FLASH sign shall be a horizontal rectangle with two yellow flashing beacons above the sign. It may be used in advance of a traffic control signal, or a special application thereof, when sight distance or other conditions require an early warning.

The need for such a sign shall be documented by an engineering study that addresses the second standard, paragraph E, Section 4D.15 of the MUTCD. Dilemma Zone protection must be considered in the design. (ODOT Traffic Signal Policy and Guidelines, Section X(G), May 2006)

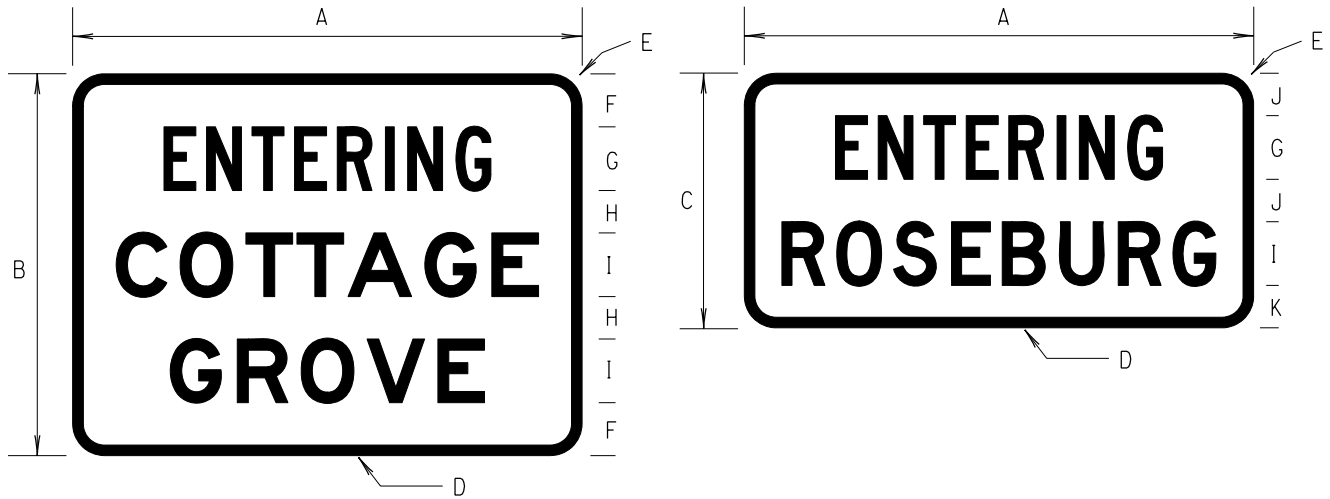

An approved city logo rider (24"x24") may be installed below the ENTERING CITY Sign. The city logo shall conform to the criteria outlined for the WELCOME TO XX (OD-413) Sign. An additional logo for an approved statewide or national program (e.g. Tree City USA, Preserve America) may also be installed below the ENTERING CITY Sign. A POPULATION Sign (OD-413A) may also be installed below the ENTERING CITY Sign. However, the number of additional signs installed below the ENTERING CITY Sign shall not be more than two.

ENTERING CITY Signs installed on the interstate highway system shall not have any signs installed below them.

An additional logo for an approved statewide or national program (e.g. Tree City USA, Preserve America) may also be installed below the ENTERING XX COUNTY Sign. However the number of additional signs installed below the ENTERING XX COUNTY Sign shall not be more than two.

ENTERING XX COUNTY Signs installed on the interstate highway system shall not have any signs installed below them.

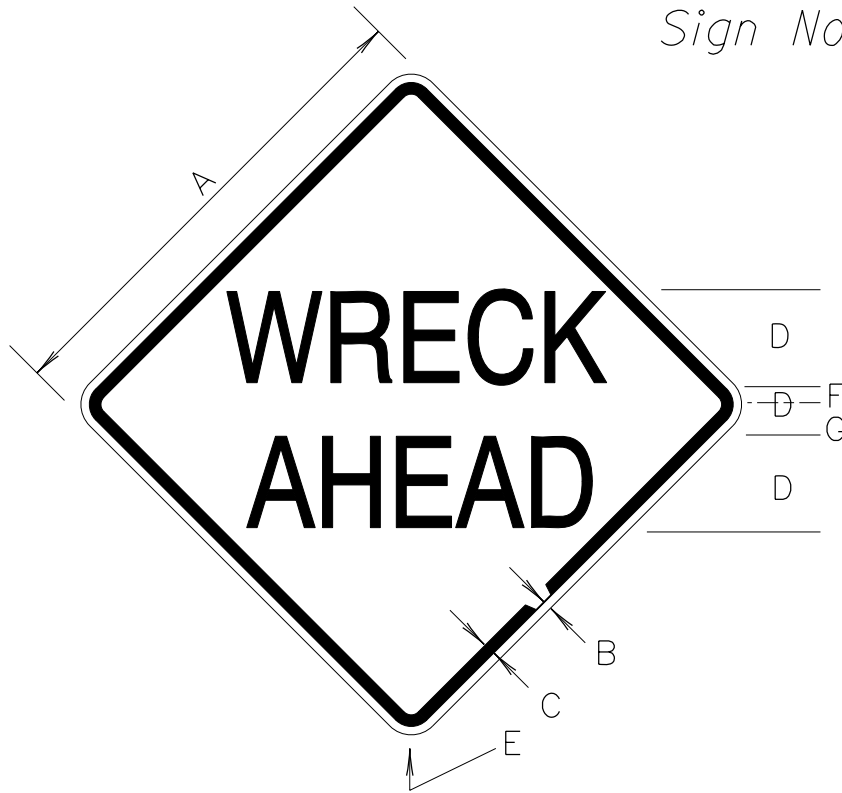
