TESTING INNOVATION IN STORMWATER: ODOT'S COLLABORATIVE STORMWATER TECHNOLOGY TREATMENT CENTER (STTC)

This facility, the Stormwater Technology Treatment Center (STTC), will verify the operation and maintenance performance and lifecycle costs of innovative, commercial-ready stormwater treatment technologies.
