SUBJECT: WEIGHT RESTRICTION – I-84 Exit 69 Overpass (Mosier)

Effective September 23, 2013, the I-84 Exit 69 overpass (Mosier / US30) will be restricted to the following weights:



22 T

Solo trucks are limited to 44,000 lbs. gross vehicle weight (22T)



34 T

Truck-Tractor/Semi-Trailer combinations are limited to 68,000 lbs. combined gross vehicle weight (34T)



40 T

Truck and Trailer combinations, doubles combinations, or triples combinations are limited to 80,000 lbs. combined gross vehicle weight (40T). No truck or trailer in any of these vehicle combinations can exceed 44,000 lbs. (22T).

This restriction is NOT on the I-84 mainline.

The weight restriction will only impact traffic heading to or from I-84 westbound Exit 69. Traffic heading to or from I-84 eastbound Exit 69 will not cross this structure.

Detour Routes:

Traffic heading to or from I-84 westbound Exit 69 that exceeds the weight limits on this overpass should use the following detour routes:

- Westbound I-84 Exit 69 to Mosier / US30: traffic should continue on I-84 westbound to Exit 64 (OR35 / East Hood River), cross under the freeway and enter I-84 eastbound; take Exit 69 to Mosier / US30.
- Traffic from Mosier / US30 to I-84 westbound: traffic should enter I-84 eastbound, take Exit 76 (Rowena), cross under the freeway and enter I-84 westbound.

Motor Carriers need to provide this information to their drivers, by copy of this letter or other means, to assure their awareness of the restriction.
