OREGON OVER-DIMENSION LOAD ENTRY POLICY

OBTAIN PERMIT PRIOR TO OPERATING IN OREGON

**TO OBTAIN AN OREGON OVER-DIMENSION PERMIT CONTACT:

Exception: Closed all State holidays

➤ **OPERATION ORIGINATES IN OREGON?**

When travel originates in Oregon, carriers must obtain variance permits **PRIOR** to operation.

➤ **WHEN OPERATION ORIGINATES OUTSIDE OF OREGON?**

When entering Oregon, carriers must obtain variance permits **PRIOR** to entry.

Exception: When entering Oregon on I-5 SB at the OR/WA Border, the carrier is allowed to go directly to Portland Bridge Office at Jantzen Beach. [See exception](http://www.oregon.gov/ODOT/MCT/docs/EntryPolicy_OD_Exception.pdf)

IMPORTANT: Drivers will be subject to a citation and fine when operating without a valid variance permit; AND the load may not proceed until your driver possesses a valid variance permit.
