**SUBJECT:** Eugene Area Ramp Closures; AND  
Portland Area Highway Closures, Ramp Closures & 12-Foot Width Restriction

Several highway projects are scheduled to begin in Eugene and Portland over the next few weeks which will result in highway closures, ramp closures, and width restrictions so that work can be performed. These projects and road restrictions are listed below:

**I-105 Westbound Off-Ramp to Northbound OR99 – Daytime Ramp Closure:**

On January 29, 2012, the I-105 Westbound off-ramp to Northbound OR99 (W 6<sup>th</sup> Ave) will be closed between the hours of 7 a.m. and 8:30 a.m. for one morning only to allow crews to repair the light poles. The estimated completion date for this work is January 29, 2012.

**Authorized Detour Route:** I-105, Delta Highway North, Beltline Highway/OR569 West, OR99

**I-105 Eastbound On-Ramp from Northbound OR99/OR126 – Daytime Ramp Closure:**

On January 29, 2012, the I-105 Eastbound on-ramp from Northbound OR99/OR126 (W 6<sup>th</sup> Ave.) will be closed between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 10 a.m. for one morning only to allow crews to repair the light poles. The estimated completion date for this work is January 29, 2012.

**Authorized Detour Route:** OR99, Beltline Highway/OR569 East, Delta Highway South, I-105 Eastbound

**US26 Eastbound Off-Ramp from Ross Island Bridge to Southbound OR99E – Daytime Ramp Closures:**

Beginning January 30, 2012, the US26 Eastbound off-ramp from the Ross Island Bridge to Southbound OR99E will be closed between the hours of 8 a.m. and 3 p.m. daily to allow crews to repair the drain pipes on the bridge. The estimated completion date for this work is February 6, 2012.

**Authorized Detour Route:** US26 East, SE 17<sup>th</sup> Ave. South, OR99E South

**I-5 Southbound Between Exit 300B and Milepost 300 – I-5 Mainline Weekend Night Closures:**

Beginning February 3, 2012, I-5 Southbound between Exit 300B and Milepost 300 will be closed on the weekends at night, as needed, to allow crews to install a catwalk on the bottom deck of the Marquam Bridge. The closures will occur from Midnight Friday until 7 a.m. Saturday and from Midnight Saturday until 8 a.m. Sunday. Closures will not occur every weekend.

**Authorized Detour Route:** I-5 South, I-405 South, I-5

**In addition, the following ramps will also be CLOSED during the same time:**

- I-84 Westbound to I-5 Southbound - CLOSED

**Authorized Detour Route:** I-84 West, I-5 North, I-405 South, I-5

- I-5 Southbound to I-405 Northbound - CLOSED

**Authorized Detour Route:** I-5 South, I-405 South

Note: The I-5 Southbound Exit 301 off-ramp to I-84 Eastbound and the I-5 Southbound Exit 300B to US26/OR99E will both remain OPEN.

The estimated completion date for this work is April 9, 2012.

**I-5 Northbound Ramp to I-405 Northbound – 12-Foot Width Restriction for One Morning:**

On February 5, 2012, the I-5 Northbound ramp to I-405 Northbound will be restricted to 12 feet 00 inches in width between the hours of 5 a.m. and 12 Noon for one morning only to allow crews to perform electrical repairs and upgrades to the existing lighting and wiring on the ramp. The estimated completion date for this work is February 5, 2012.

**Authorized Detour Route:** I-5 North, I-405 South

**St. Johns Bridge Off-Ramp (from US30 Bypass) to Westbound US30; AND**

**US30 Eastbound Off-Ramp to Northbound St. Johns Bridge (to US30 Bypass) - Closed for One Day:**

On February 12, 2012, NW Bridge Ave. will be closed in both directions between the St. Johns Bridge and NW Springville Rd. between the hours of 6 a.m. and 2 p.m. for one day only to allow crews to perform bridge repairs. During this time, there will be no access to US30 Westbound from the St. Johns Bridge or access to the St. Johns Bridge from US30 Eastbound. The estimated completion date for this work is February 12, 2012.

Motor Carriers need to provide this information to their drivers, by copy of this letter or other means, to assure their awareness of the restriction.
