

**SUBJECT:** **RAMP CLOSURES: I-5 SOUTH EXIT 302B TO I-405 SOUTH & I-5 SOUTH ON-RAMP FROM GOING STREET - PORTLAND**

On Friday night, October 19, 2012, the I-5 Southbound Exit 302B off-ramp to I-405 Southbound will be closed between the hours of 10 PM & 6 AM for bridge maintenance and attenuator repairs. In addition, the I-5 Southbound on-ramp from Going Street will also be closed during the same time. The estimated completion date for this work is 6 AM on Saturday morning, October 20, 2012.



## **Detour Routes:**

When the I-5 South Exit 302B off-ramp to I-405 South is closed, traffic can take I-5 South across the Marquam Bridge then take I-405 North.

When the I-5 South on-ramp from Going St. is closed, traffic can enter I-5 North and take the Rosa Parks Exit 304, cross over the freeway and enter I-5 South.

Motor Carriers need to provide this information to their drivers, by copy of this letter or other means, to assure their awareness of the restriction.
