SUBJECT: **WIDTH RESTRICTIONS – OR99E MP 12 TO MP 20.63 NB & SB (OREGON CITY TO CANBY)**
HEIGHT RESTRICTIONS – OR99E MP 12.39 NB & MP 12.62 NB (OREGON CITY)

Beginning June 24, 2012, width and height restrictions will be in effect on OR99E between Oregon City and Canby due to a paving project. The estimated completion date for this project is September 30, 2012.

The width and height restrictions are as follows:

Width Restrictions (Oregon City to Canby):

OR99E MP 12 to MP 20.63 Northbound & Southbound:

- Restricted to loads no greater than 14 feet 00 inches in width from 1/2 hr before sunrise until 1/2 hr after sunset. Mobile/modular units with eaves are authorized provided the base width does not exceed 14 feet 00 inches in width.
- Restricted to loads no greater than 10 feet 00 inches in width from 1/2 hr after sunset until 1/2 hr before sunrise.

Height Restrictions (Oregon City):

OR99E Northbound MP 12.62 crossing through the Oregon City Tunnel:

- Restricted to loads no greater than 14 feet 05 inches in height at this location (due to left lane closures requiring traffic to use the right lane, which has lower vertical clearance).

OR99E Northbound MP 12.39 crossing under OR43:

- Restricted to loads no greater than 14 feet 00 inches in height at this location (due to left lane closures requiring traffic to use the right lane, which has lower vertical clearance).

Detour Route:

Motor carriers exceeding the above dimensions will need to use alternate routes during this time. Refer to the annual permit for authorized alternate routes for operations under an annual overheight permit.
